



Information and Entry Marathon (42.195 km /26.2 mi)

23rd DRESDEN-MARATHON, 22/10/2023

Sightseeing step by step. Baroque and natural, as far as your feet are. Highlights are the historic old town with its well-known sights and the new town, the well-known pub-and Gründerzeit-style quarter.

The flat, fast route leads you over the Waldschlösschenbrücke and through the Grosser Garten and along the meadows of the Elbe river.

The second round, half different from the first, also includes a loop through the Blasewitz district with a wonderful view of the castles on the Loschwitz Elbhang. More than 300 musicians with numerous bands create the mood for you before you run into the great marathon finish with the applause of numerous spectators at the MARITIM HOTEL.

REGISTRATION

Runners born in 2005 and older are eligible to participate.

Registration takes place online via the website www.dresden-marathon.com. By registering, each participant declares that they have read and accepted the general terms and conditions. In the case of group registrations and registration by third parties, the applicant declares that all registered persons have read and accepted the terms and conditions.



Each participant gets his own bib number. The bib number is not transferable. The transponder for time measurement is integrated in the bib number. It is clearly visible and must be worn unchanged on the front of the jersey and must not be kinked or covered.

There is NO participant limit at the DRESDEN-MARATHON.

The registration deadline is on October 9, 2023, midnight.

Late online-registrations are possible from October 10, 2023, midnight to October 19, 2023, midnight.

Late registrations at the International Congress Center Dresden will be accepted from October 20, 2023, 3 p.m. to October 22, 2023, 9:30 a.m.

Further changes and corrections are to be made at the bib number issue (help desk) for a processing fee of € 5.00*. *) incl. VAT

ENTRY FEE / REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

The entry fee varies depending on when you register:

There will be NOT additional costs for timekeeping.

Foreign participants can choose between payment by credit card, by PayPal or SEPA direct debit.

Participation in the SEPA procedure requires subscription of the "Adherence Agreements of the European Payments Council (EPC)" by the payment service provider.

Incorrect information and associated fees or remittances are at the expense of the participant.

Immediately after successful online registration, a registration confirmation with the bib number will be sent. All participants who have registered by midnight on October 19th, 2023 will receive a registration confirmation shortly before the event to the specified email address. When picking up the bib numbers the submission of the registration confirmation as a printout or digitally is mandatory. The collection by another person is possible with a power of attorney and the official registration confirmation.

After registration, there is no entitlement to reimbursement of the registration fee consisting of the organizational fee plus the fee for booked additional services or the issuing of a voucher for a subsequent event (see Terms and Conditions).

Runners born in 2005 and older are eligible to participate.

Participation is at your own risk. Upon receipt of their bib number, all starters declare that there are no health concerns regarding their participation. In order to support an optimal start to physical activity and to prevent possible health risks, we ask that you fill out the short questionnaire on health carefully. The data are provided by the German Sport University Cologne scientifically documented. An evaluation of your information is provided at the end of the questionnaire. APPROACH

The competition area is close to the main train station (approx. 2 km) and the Dresden-Neustadt train station (approx. 1 km). Dresden International Airport is approximately 8 km away. For the timetable information of the Dresden transport company, go to: <https://www.dvb.de/en-gb/>.

You can reach the marathon starting area by car and bus via BAB 4, junction Dresden-Altstadt (78), continue on B 6 for approx. 3 km towards the CITYCENTER/MESSE DRESDEN. Follow the parking lot signage "MARATHON" and "MESSE/P7".

DESTINATION FOR NAVIGATION DEVICE: 01067 Dresden, Messering 6. From other directions, diversions and road closures can be expected on marathon day.

The start / finish area is in the area of Pieschener Allee/Devrientstrasse, approx. 800m away from the city center of Dresden (Zwinger, Semperoper).

The bib number issue, the registration office and the marathon expo are located in the International Congress Center Dresden (Ostraufer/corner of Devrientstrasse). The start-finish area is easily accessible by public transport. The start number is valid on October 22, 2023 as a ticket in all forms of public transport - except special transport - in the Dresden tariff zone. It is around a 5-minute walk from the Postplatz tram junction and the Dresden-Mitte S-Bahn station. Tram lines 6 and 11 take you to the "Congress Center".

Please note the diversions of the Dresden public transport company on the day of the race.

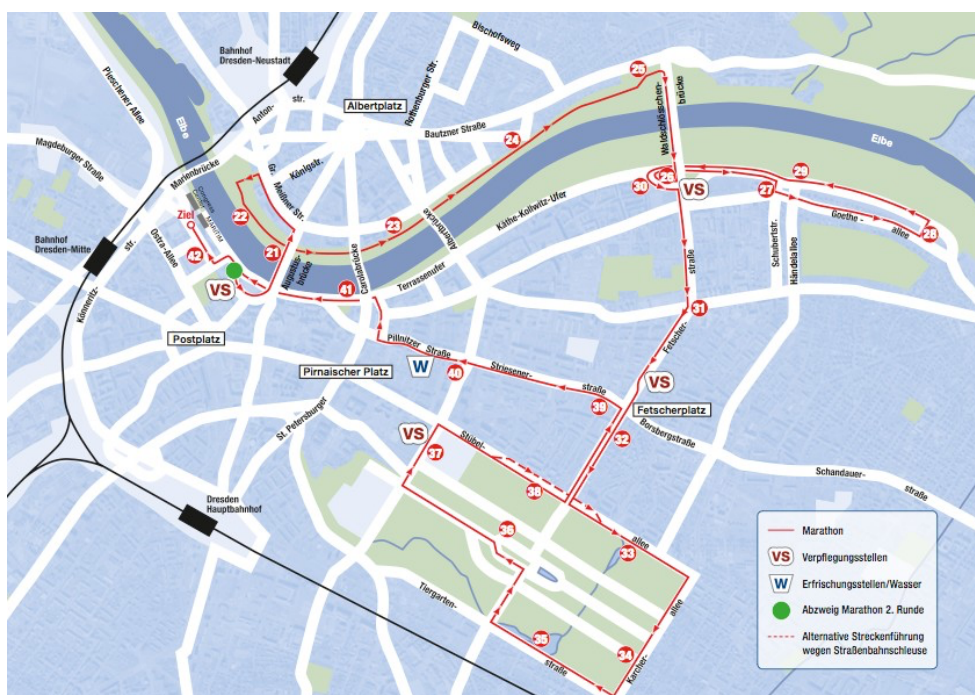

TIMEKEEPING

The running time is measured exclusively by means of an RFID transponder attached to the back of your bib number. Please fix the bib number using the safety pins at chest level. The bib number must not be kinked, covered or changed. Otherwise the timekeeping cannot be guaranteed. Gun and chip times will be available in the results. The finishers will be evaluated according to the chip time (effective running time), the start and finish as well as all control mats laid out on the course.

There will be no extra fee for the transponder. It is not necessary to return the transponder.

LUGGAGE DEPOSIT

Facilities are located in the underground car park of the International Congress Center. Don't forget to write your race number on your official starting bag before you hand it in at the respective (signposted) deposit desk. It is not possible to deposit your bags at the marathon starting point! The clothing bags have to be picked up by 5 p.m. latest. The organizer does not take on any liability for damage or loss of luggage.

STARTING LINE-UP

From 10.10 a.m. at Pieschener Allee (approx. 700m from the Congress Center).
Starting blocks (marking of your bib number): A+E (Elite) / B / C.

FOOD AND REFRESHMENT POINTS

There will be food points at km 10 / 16 / 20.6 / 26 / 30 / 31.6 / 37 and at the finish. Tea, Water, Xenofit Iso-drinks, bananas and raisin bread is offered.

On the second round there are also Xenofit energy bars and gel as well as Coke and salt being offered.

At the refreshment points at km 5,5 / 19 and 39,8 pure still water will be offered.

Additionally, at the finish there will be an offer of tea, apples, water melons and ERDINGER non-alcoholic beer.

To avoid collisions, we ask that you use the entire length of the supply points.

CEP-PACERS-SERVICE

In cooperation with the CEP paceteam, the organizer provides its proven pacemakers for the following target times:
3:00 / 3:15 / 3:30 / 3:45 / 4:00 / 4:15 / 4:30 hrs.

ALTERATION OF RACE TRACK / TURNING POINT

Should you decide to run only the half marathon after the first round you have to contact the help desk immediately after crossing the finish line in order to be registered and classified.

ATTENTION: Participants who have not reached the turning point at km 20.5 until 2 hours and 45 minutes after the start (that is at 1.15 p.m.) will either be taken out of the race or will be classified as participants in the half marathon (at their own request) if they cross the finish line.



GOOD TO KNOW AFTER THE RACE

ENGRAVING OF MEDALS / PHOTOSERVICE

Right after the race you have the possibility to have your name and your net running time engraved in your participant's medal at the finish area. You can book this service when you register (€ 8.00*). Then a medal symbol is printed on your start number. Please show the start number at the medal engraving.

If you decide at short notice, you can also pay on site in cash (€ 10.00*).

Showers, changing rooms and toilets are available in the finish area. Current information and the map can be found on the runner information, which is available with the bib number.

PRESENTATION CEREMONY / MEDALS

After having successfully crossed the finish-line, each participant is presented a high-quality finisher medal.

The overall winners of the marathon will be honored in the presentation ceremony at around 1.50 p.m. (men) and 1.50 p.m. (women).

At around 2.30 p.m. the marathon presentation ceremonies of all age ranks will begin.
