AOK 10KM RUN

25th DRESDEN-MARATHON

Sun, 26/10/2025 - **8:30 a.m.**

NEW STARTING TIME!

A fast 10K through DRESDEN – whether you're chasing a new personal best or running 10 kilometers non-stop for the first time as a beginner, this race has something for everyone. The **AOK 10K Run** is the most popular race distance at the **DRESDEN MARATHON** after the half marathon.

You'll start at the Pieschener Allee. After crossing the Elbe River, you'll explore the **Innere Neustadt**, passing the **Japanese Palace** and Dresden's government district. On the way to the **Waldschlößchen Bridge**, you'll experience the stunning natural beauty of the **Elbe meadows**.

After a second crossing of the Elbe, the route continues along the riverside bike path on the left bank. You'll run along the water back into the historic Old Town, directly beneath the **Brühl's Terrace**, past the **Semper Opera House**, and through the **marathon gate** of the **Heinz-Steyer-Stadium**. Cheered on by the crowd, you'll finish with half a lap around the track, crossing the grand finish line of the **25th DRESDEN MARATHON**.

ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION

All runners born in 2011 or earlier are eligible to participate.

Registration is available online at www.dresden-marathon.com. By registering, each participant acknowledges and accepts the General Terms and Conditions of Dresdner Laufevents und Touristik GmbH.

In the case of group or third-party registrations, the registering person confirms that all registered individuals have read and accepted the Terms and Conditions.

Each runner will receive a personal bib number, which is non-transferable. The timing transponder is integrated into the bib and must be worn visibly and unaltered on the front of the running shirt. It must not be bent or covered.

Registration Deadlines

- **Online late registration:** October 14, 12:00 a.m. – October 23, 2025, 11:59 p.m.

 - o Oct 26: 07:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.

Late registration on Sunday, October 26, 2025 is only possible at the pavilion in front of the **BallsportARENA**, at the special 10k-race packet pick-up area.

Name changes or distance changes are free of charge until October 13, 2025.

REGISTRATION FEES / CONFIRMATION

The organizational fee (including bib number and timing chip) depends on the registration date:

Until Jun 30, 2025: €34^[*]
Until Oct 13, 2025: €40^[*]
Late registration: €47^[*]

Participants who register by October 23, 2025 (11:59 p.m.) will receive a registration confirmation via email. This confirmation must be presented (digitally or printed) when picking up race materials. Collection by a third party requires a signed authorization and the official confirmation.

Starter lists can be viewed at www.dresden-marathon.com. If you register by October 13, 2025, your race kit can be shipped **within** Germany for a service fee (see prices on "BIB NUMBER PICKUP"). Shipping begins on October 13, 2025. ^[**]

The registration fee (organizational fee + any booked extras like the anniversary party, medal engraving, or bib mailing) must be paid via SEPA direct debit or PayPal. Any errors and fees due to incorrect information are the responsibility of the participant.

Foreign participants may pay by credit card, PayPal or SEPA direct debit (subject to the payment provider's participation in the European Payments Council agreements).

There is no refund of the registration fee or extras in case of non-participation, including illness. No vouchers or deferrals will be issued (see Terms & Conditions).

We recommend picking up your race kit on Friday or Saturday to avoid stress and enjoy the marathon expo.

NEW: Participants who register by Oct 13 and pay the extra fee will receive their complete race kit by mail (Germany only, starting Oct 13).^[**]

For Group registration: Up to 4 people=15 €^[*], 5-20 people=20 €^[*], 21+ people=25 €^[*]

COURSE

The course is a flat, officially (DLV) measured loop marked every 1 km.

The AOK 10K Run can also be completed by walkers (without poles!).

There is no separate ranking, but walkers will be assigned to a separate start block "W" at the back of the field.

The AOK 10K race begins with a flying start. The starting line-up takes place on Pieschener Allee beneath the large marathon start arch. After the starting signal, there is a stretch of about 150–200 meters to the AOK arch, where the official timing begins.

Following the direct crossing of the River Elbe, you will explore the Innere Neustadt, passing the Japanisches Palais and the Golden Rider before descending the "Blockhaus Ramp" onto the Elbe Cycle Path. On the way to the Waldschlösschen Bridge, you will experience the beautiful natural scenery of the Dresden Elbe meadows. After crossing the Elbe again, the route continues along the riverside cycle path on the left bank. You will run along the water back into the Old Town, passing directly beneath the Brühl's Terrace, past the Semper Opera House, and on to the marathon gate of Heinz-Steyer-Stadion. With the cheers of countless spectators and a half lap around the stadium track, you will cross the grand finish line of the 25th DRESDEN-MARATHON.





PARTICIPATION RULES / DATA PRIVACY

All participants must be born in 2011 or earlier.

The General Terms and Conditions of Dresdner Laufevents und Touristik GmbH apply (available at www.dresden-marathon.com or upon request).

Use of inline skates, baby joggers, dogs, or unauthorized bicycles is prohibited and results in disqualification. Participation is at your own risk. By registering, you confirm that you are physically fit and have trained sufficiently. We strongly recommend a medical check-up beforehand. The organizer accepts no liability for health risks.

Lost items will be stored at the info stand during the event and for 14 days at the organizer's office (HEINZ-STEYER-STADIUM, Magdeburger Str. 2, 01067 Dresden).

HOW TO GET THERE

The race area is located near the “Dresden-Hauptbahnhof”-mainstation (approx. 2 km) and “Dresden-Neustadt”-station (approx. 1 km). Dresden International Airport is about 8 km away. For local public transport schedules, please visit: www.dvb.de.

By car or bus, the marathon start can be reached via the A4 motorway, exit Dresden-Altstadt (78), then continue approx. 3 km on the B6 in the direction of the city centre/exhibition grounds. Follow the signs for “MARATHON” and “MESSE/P7”.

Please note: On marathon day, detours and road closures may apply when coming from other directions.

The start/finish area is located near Pieschener Allee/HEINZ-STEYER STADIUM, approximately 800 metres from Dresden city centre (Zwinger Palace, Semper Opera House).

Race packet pick-up, registration office, and the marathon expo are located at:

BallsportARENA Dresden | Weißeritzstraße 4 | 01067 Dresden.

The start/finish area is easily accessible by public transport. Your bib number is valid as a ticket for all local public transport (excluding special services) in the Dresden fare zone on October 26, 2025.

From the Postplatz tram hub and the S-Bahn station Dresden-Mitte, it's about a 10-minute walk. Tram lines 6 and 11 will take you to the “Kongresszentrum” stop.

Please check for public transport detours on race day.



RACE DAY INFO

START: Sun, Oct 26, 2025 – **8:30 a.m.** on PIESCHENER ALLEE

NEW STARTING TIME!

FINISH LINE CLOSES: 10:30 a.m. in HEINZ-STEYER-STADIUM DRESDEN

If a participant does **NOT** reach the Heinz-Steyer-Stadium by latest **10:30 a.m.**, they must unfortunately leave the course. From **10:30 a.m.**, marathon and half marathon runners will be approaching in the opposite direction at Ostra-Ufer.

TIMING

Timing is done via RFID disposable transponder integrated into your bib.
Attach your bib at chest height using the provided safety pins.
Do not fold, cover, or alter the bib—otherwise your time may not be recorded.

Both gross and net times are recorded. Rankings are based on net times.

There is no additional timing chip fee. No chip return required.

BAG DROP

Label your official clothing bag with your bib number and drop it off at the designated area (tent behind Heinz-Steyer-Stadium).

NO bag drop at the starting line.

Bags must be collected by 5:00 p.m. The organizer is not liable for lost or damaged items.

STARTING LINE-UP

From 08:00 a.m. on Pieschener Allee
Starting blocks based on bib number: E (Elite), A, B, C, W.

POST-RACE SERVICES

MEDAL ENGRAVING / PHOTOS

Medals can be engraved at the finish area:

Pre-booked: €10^[*] (symbol on bib)

On site (cash only): €15^[*]

Official race photos will be available from marathonphotos.live. A link to your personal photos will be emailed after the event.

SHOWERS / CHANGING ROOMS / TOILETS

Available at the finish area. See race packet for up-to-date info and maps.

AWARDS & RESULTS

Every finisher receives a medal.
